

Botox Abbotsford

Botox Abbotsford - Skin wrinkles are by definition a ridge, crease or fold in the skin. The wrinkles of the skin normally show as a result of aging, consisting of: the lengthened immersion of the skin in water or glycation. The wrinkling of the skin is caused by sun damage, aging, habitual facial expressions, smoking, poor hydration and various other elements. Skin wrinkles in the water caused by lengthened water exposure that causes the outer layer of skin to absorb water. Depletion of water within the body as with dehydration likewise can lead to the puckering of the skin. Cortisol is another element that results in degradation of skin collagen.

Dermal fillers are frequently used to be able to treat wrinkles and different skin depressions. They are injectable products that are often a type of soft tissue. Dermal fillers are designed to enable injection into the skin for purposes of improving the appearance of the skin. The most popular products are based on hyaluronic acid.

Botulinum Toxin

The neurotoxin protein, botulinum toxin, is made by the bacterium *Clostridium botulinum*. The most common kind of botulinum toxin is known as "Botox," or onabotulinumtoxinA. This specific type of botulinum toxin is made by Allergan Inc. for both therapeutic and cosmetic usage. Botox is made use of in the treatment of migraine headache and spasmodic dystonia or spasmodic torticollis that is a neuromuscular disorder that involves the neck and head. Botox has numerous uses along with its cosmetic application.

During the year 2009, Americans now had a new accessible form of botulinum toxin. This new form, made by Ipsen, is referred to as abotulinumtoxinA or Dysport. It has been given FDA approval and is now used to treat glabellar lines in adults along with cervical dystonia. Dysport and Botox on the other hand, are not the same since the molecular structure of the two drugs is different.

The Botulinum toxin is able to remedy a lot of wrinkles by relaxing or immobilizing the muscles which cause wrinkles. This particular toxin is not suitable for the remedy of all wrinkles, as is seen with glabellar lines, which occur between the eyebrows in adults. Any other use of this toxin is considered "off-label" use and is not approved by the FDA.
